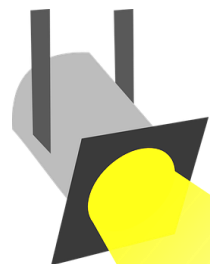


The largest snowman on record was 22 feet tall with a 12 foot base. Like the one in the picture below!
